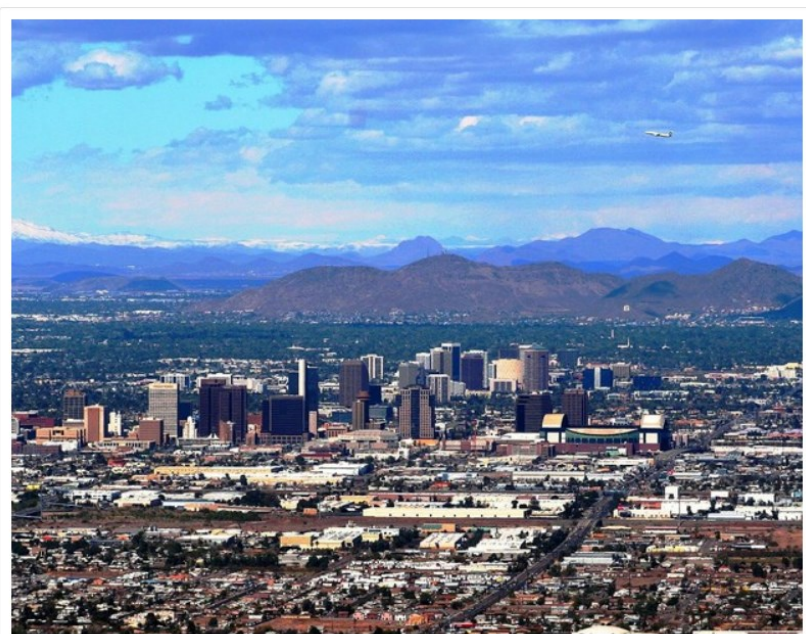

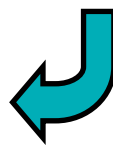


## Let's be a scientist!
